THE HISTORY OF SÄNTIS MALT

1886

The story of the Locher family and their art of brewing begins in Oberegg in the 19th century. In 1886, the family acquires the brewery in Appenzell, which is still a brewery and distillery today.

1999

After the ban on the production of cereal spirits was lifted, master brewer Karl Locher, known for his creative beer varieties, starts producing Säntis Malt in history-steeped beer barrels, using Alpstein spring water.

2002

Brauerei Locher AG launches its first products on the market, going down in the history books as a pioneer of Swiss whisky production.

2003

Brauerei Locher AG also uses barley from Switzerland's highest growing areas. This raw material gains vitality and strength from the extreme weather conditions in the mountains.

2010

The Appenzeller Säntis Malt Edition «Dreifaltigkeit» is named European Whisky of the Year 2010 by whisky expert Jim Murray.

2011

Brauerei Locher AG is voted «Whisky Distillery 2011» by the Swiss Whisky Guide.

2012

First entries in the world-leading International Wine & Spirit Competition (IWSC) in London. All of the whiskies submitted receive an award.

2013

Once again, all of the whiskies submitted receive awards at the IWSC. The special edition «Alpstein 2013» is the first whisky from the German-speaking world to win a gold medal. The limited winter edition «Snow White» is launched for the first time.

2015

The Säntis Malt Edition «Germany Nr. 2» is awarded «Gold» and the Edition «Alpstein X» receives the «Silver Outstanding» award at the IWSC in London.

2019

The Säntis Malt distillery celebrates its 20th anniversary. Bottling of the first Edition «Genesis» – a new limited series that honours the origin and history behind the casks. The Edition «Alpstein XV» and Edition «Genesis Nr. 1» receive silver medals at the IWSC. The Edition «Föhnsturm» and Edition «Snow White 6» win bronze. Launch of the new «Golfer's Birdie Water» single malt whisky.

2020

The Edition «Alpstein XVI» receives a silver medal at the IWSC in London. The Edition «Golfer's Birdie Water» and Edition «Snow White 7» both win bronze. Premiere of the Edition «Genesis Nr. 2» with Acolon finish and Edition «Snow White 8» with Pineau des Charentes Finish. Launch of the new «Bärli Biber Whisky Liqueurs» in collaboration with Bischofberger AG in Weissbad.

2021

Launch of the «Single Cask Exploration Series», which celebrates the diversity of the casks in our cellars. Gold award for Edition «Liechtenstein» at the Swiss Spirits Review and silver for «Genesis Nr. 2». «Alpstein XVII», «Rum Cask» and «Genesis Nr. 2» all win silver at the IWSC in London, while «Snow White 8» receives a bronze medal.

2022

The number of casks stored exceeds 4,000 for the first time. Launch of «Karl Locher's 60th Founder's Anniversary Reserve» – the first Swiss whisky to feature NFT and NFC technology. Gold at the World Whisky Awards for Edition «Alpstein XVII» – both as «Category Winner» and «Best Swiss Single Malt Whisky».

2023

Launch of the new Edition «Triple Cask», triple-matured in beer, port and sherry casks. Double gold and category winner at Distisuisse 2023 for «Alpstein XIX – Sherry» and «Pinot Noir Cask Nr. 1330».

2024

World Whisky Awards 2024: Gold and Category Winner for «Alpstein XIX – Sherry». Silver medals for «Snow White Nr. 11 – Williams» and Single Cask «Monbazillac Nr. 21311». Jim Murray's Whisky Bible 2024 awards «Dreifaltigkeit» 95 points.

EDITION SIGEL

Our Sântis Malt «Edition Sigel» obtains its flavour notes from storage in oak beer casks that are over 130 years old. Jim Murray described it as follows: «An exclusive aroma and a pure malt that melts in the mouth, combined with a juicy fruitiness and light spices. Vanilla represents the oak in the friendliest way.»

EDITION ALPSTEIN

The multi-award-winning Sântis Malt «Edition Alpstein» owes its quality to initial maturation in history-steeped oak beer casks. It develops its incomparable aroma during finishing in a cask that once held bourbon, port, sherry or another speciality. This whisky is bottled as a continuous limited edition.

EDITION LIECHTENSTEIN

A hallmark Sântis Malt with a royal finish. In keeping with tradition, the «Liechtenstein Edition» is aged in history-steeped oak beer casks, some of which are over 100 years old. To achieve the perfect flavour and maturation, it is then aged for several more years in selected red wine casks from the Cellars of the Prince of Liechtenstein.

AGED IN BEER AND PINOT NOIR CASKS FROM THE PRINCELY WINE ESTATE

EDITION KAMOR

The Sântis Malt «Edition Kamor» glows an elegant amber yellow in the glass, delighting with its fine smoky notes, vanilla and toffee aromas. Full-bodied, with hints of peaty potting soil and Virginia tobacco. The long, balanced finish combines smoke and malty sweetness – a whisky for lovers of elegance packed with character.

AGED IN ANCIENT BEER CASKS
48% vol. - 4cl, 20cl, 50cl, 70cl



FÖHNSTURM

A mélange of complex flavours. After ageing for four to five years in beer casks, our «Föhnsturm» undergoes finishing for several months, during which it absorbs flavours from various wine casks, imparting both sweet and fruity notes. The finishing process is interrupted precisely when distinct aromas of ageing are still discernible in the beer casks and the second ageing notes are not yet dominant.

APRICOT MALT LIQUEUR

Our Apricot Malt Liqueur is a sweet, fruity delicacy made from beer cask-aged Sântis Malt Whisky and aromatic apricots. The nose reveals lots of apricot, juicy peach notes, light almond aromas and a hint of rose water. Apricot also features on the palate, albeit awash with brandy this time. It has a surprisingly strong and long-lasting finish that very few liqueurs can match.

GOLFER'S BIRDIE WATER

A fine game – spicy-sweet notes from decades-old beer casks blend with fruity accents from former sherry casks to create a truly unique taste experience.

SNOW WHITE

Each year, the Winter Edition, limited to 2,000 bottles, conjures up a surprise with a new design and a fruity finish. Single malt whisky aged in beer casks, completed by a second ageing in casks that previously contained fruit brandy. Be it a Vieille Prune, Vieille Poire, cherry brandy, apricot or orange finish – «Snow White» skilfully showcases the flavour of the whisky while retaining the taste of the fruit.

EDITION MARWEES

Our «Edition Marwees» is created from our award-winning Sântis Malt «Edition Sigel». After ageing, it is transformed into a delicious speciality by adding thick cream. A sweet drop with nougat and caramel notes, thick consistency, and a pleasant, smooth finish.

This unique liqueur was created together with the family-run Bischofberger AG in Weissbad, which has 70 years of experience in the production of the finest «Biber» (filled gingerbread). The finest Appenzeller Sântis Malt Whisky combines with Biber spices, creating an aromatic bonfire that is sure to warm any winter night.

EDITION HIMMELBERG

The spring water for our Sântis Malt «Edition Himmelberg», and all our whiskies, comes from the Alpstein mountain range. The secret lies in the transfer of the whisky from beer casks to various wine casks. Julia Nourney characterises it as follows: «Light and fruity, which shows its true colours on the palate with spicy and woody aromas».

TRIPLE CASK

A composition of our choice casks. Distilled at the foot of the Alpstein mountains and traditionally aged in beer casks that are up to 130 years old, this whisky acquires its hallmark «Sântis Malt» character. Subsequent storage in selected sherry and port casks enriches it with an even more complex structure and full body. Aged for seven years, this assemblage of three cask types is a unique symphony of flavours from the past.
